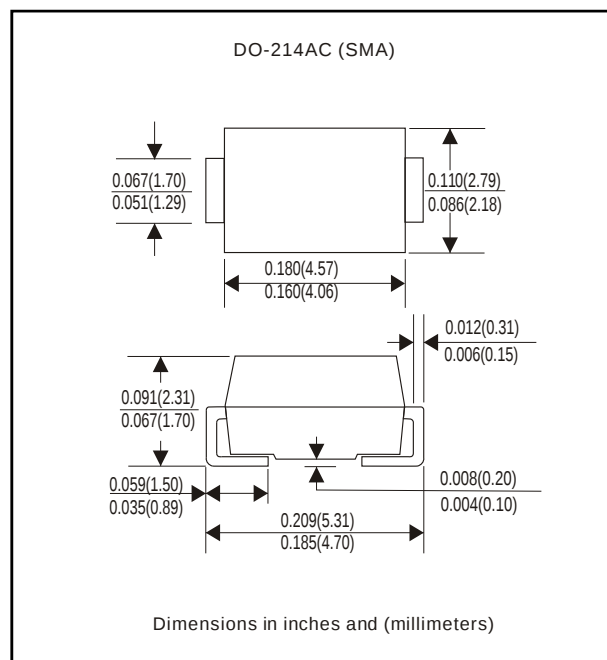

FIG.1-TYPICAL FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

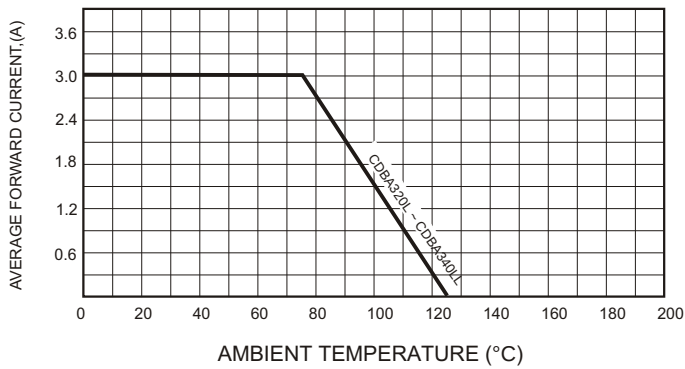


FIG.2-MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

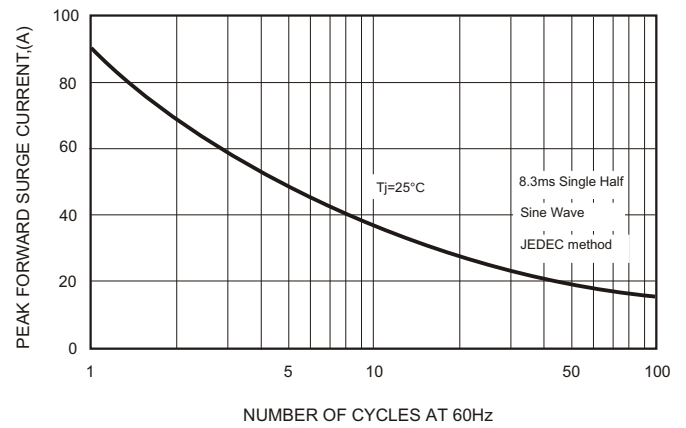


FIG.3-TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

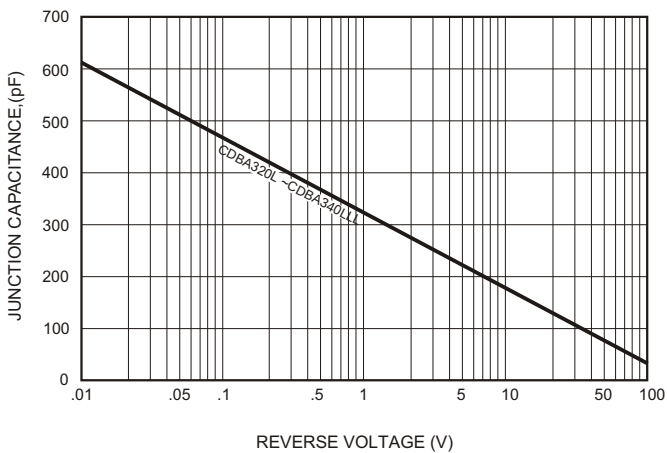
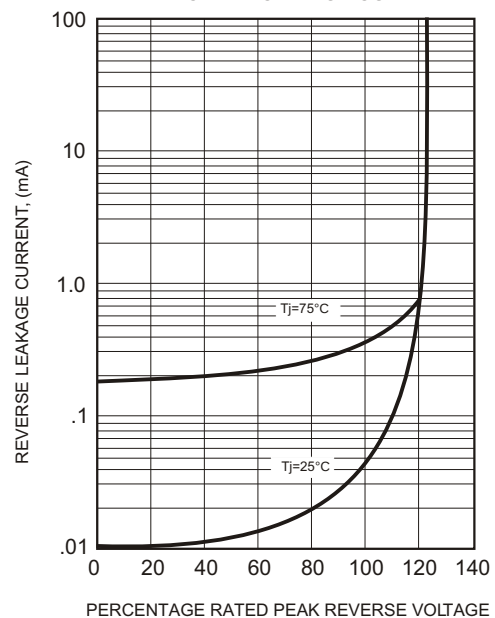


FIG.4 - TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

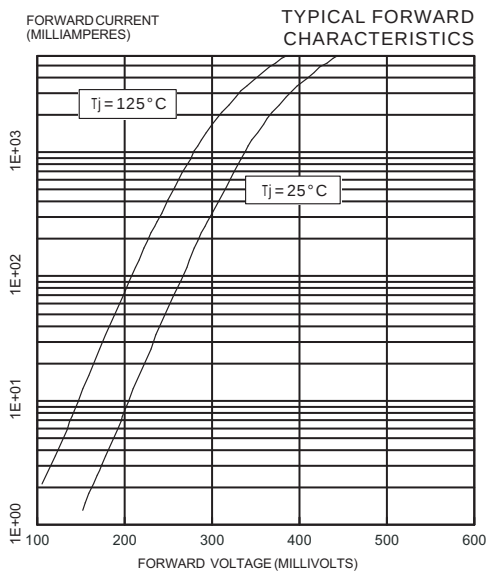


FIG. 6 (For CDBA320LL)

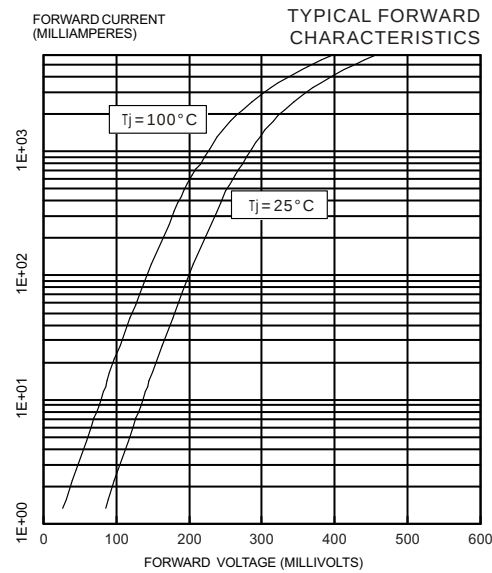


FIG. 7 (For CDBA340L)

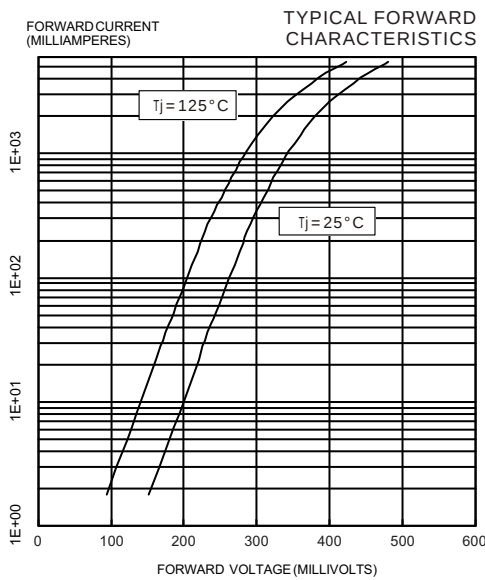


FIG. 8 (For CDBA340LL)
