

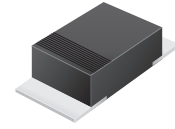

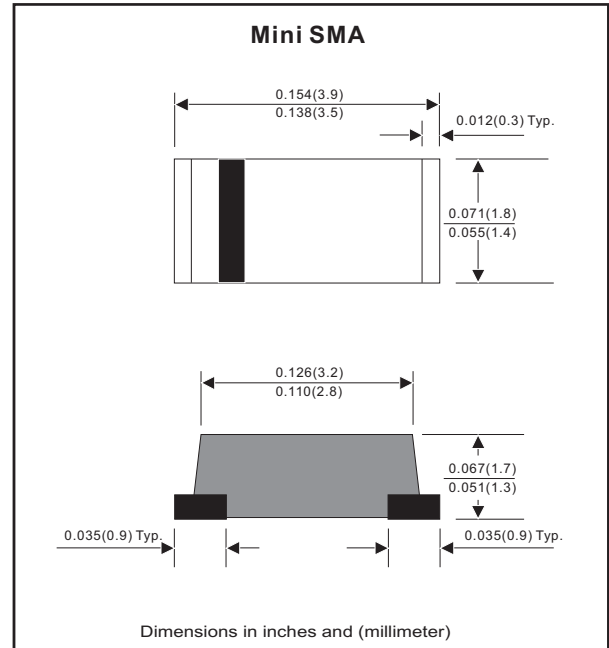

Fig.1 - Forward Characteristics

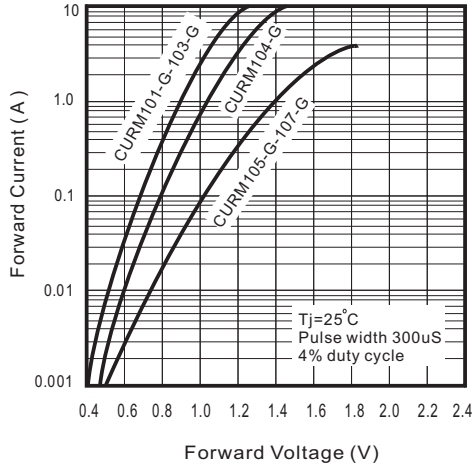


Fig.2 - Junction Capacitance

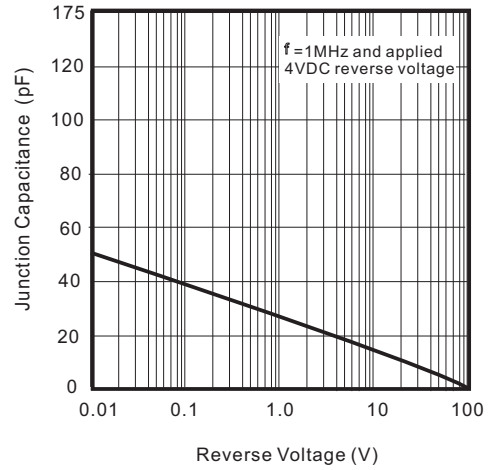
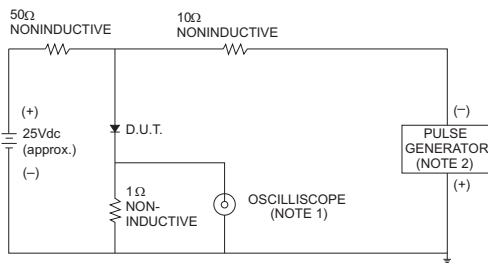


Fig. 3 - Test Circuit Diagram and Reverse Recovery Time Characteristics

2. Rise Time= 10ns max., Source Impedance= 50 ohms.

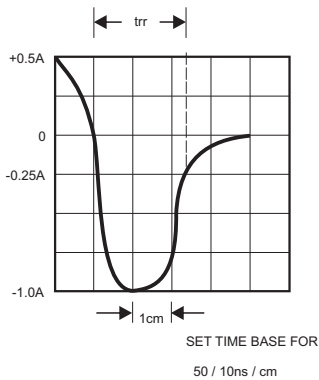


Fig. 4 - Non Repetitive Forward Surge Current

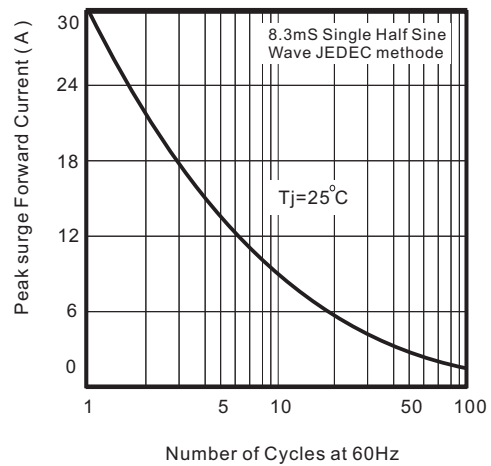


Fig. 5 - Current Derating Curve
